Headquarters

Fulbeck Village Hall, Lincoln Road, Fulbeck, Lincolnshire NG32 3JW

Signing in and out will be on the green outside the hall. The hall will be open for the use of toilet facilities only. Competitors are asked not to gather at the village hall before or after the event. In line with current CTT requirements refreshments will not be provided.

The HQ is 1.2 miles from the course.

There is no parking at the Village Hall. Parking is permitted on the wide grass verge on the A607 just to the north of the Hall. Please park perpendicular to the road to make best use of the space available. If you park elsewhere, please do so with consideration to local residents.

Route from HQ to start

From the HQ head north on the A607 to the traffic lights on the cross roads in Leadenham. Turn right and the start is just ahead at the field entrance.

Course details

Start at dropped kerb, entrance to field, east of the cottage after the junction of A607 with Sleaford Road (old A17). Proceed eastwards to finish at the furthest point of the lay-by (east side), which is after the minor cut through road to Pottergate Road (0.75 miles)

Local regulations

- 1. Riders must not warm up on the course when the event is in progress
- 2. There must be no U-turns in the vicinity of the start and finish areas
- 3. After the finish riders must continue to take the next left turn onto Pottergate Road, then take the next left turn (a cut through back to Sleaford Road / Leadenham Hill). At the junction of Sleaford Road, take care to avoid riders on the course and turn right down the hill, back to the HQ
- 4. Any rider observed riding in a manner which my jeopardise his or her own safety or the safety of others will be disqualified and reported to CTT Lincolnshire DC
- 5. All riders must have a working rear light fitted to the back of the bicycle / tricycle, either flashing or constant, and that they turn it on during the event.
- All competitors under the age of 18 years and/or Juniors must wear a properly affixed helmet which
 must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such
 as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.
- 7. All Competitors must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

- (b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
