Route from HQ to start

The start is opposite the HQ in Caird Avenue SZ251944

Course details

Start in Caird Avenue opposite the Scout Hut, turn left immediately on to A337 and proceed East to Lymington. SZ318953. At the Lymington one way system get into the right hand lane (towards Town Centre) and TURN RIGHT Queen Street GIVING WAY TO TRAFFIC FROM LEFT then left into St. Thomas's Street which becomes the High Street. Beware of pedestrians in road. There is a fast descent with bollards 2metres out in the road to a sharp left turn at the bottom of the road into Gosport Street. SZ326956. Proceed for 400metres to mini roundabout where TURN RIGHT (2nd exit) to Bridge Road SZ326959. Beware of traffic lights and uneven level crossing.SZ325969. Continue over level crossing and river bridge and bear left on B3054 then right up hill and continue through Portmore. Over cattle grid at SZ340976 to Hatchet pond SU370017 where turn RIGHT, giving way to traffic from left (10.8 miles). Proceed to Beaulieu wherecontinue straight on past the national motor museum SU382028 to junction with A35 at Lyndhurst. SU303081. (CATTLE GRID) (19miles). Turn left, beware of prdestrian controlled traffic lights and bear left into Gosport Lane. Get into the RIGHT HAND LANE and keep right (one way traffic) bearing right, then straight on, signposted Bournemouth. At the junction turn left with care (traffic from right) to rejoin the A35 (20 miles).Proceed on A35, beware of sharp descent at Holmsley with minor roads to left and right (SU232005)to crossroads at Cat and Fiddle pub (SZ205952) (30.3 miles). Turn left through Walkford (built up area, pedestrian controlled traffic lights) to roundabout where left to join A337 to FINISH at gates to Fawcetts field sports ground. No stopping or u-turns at finish, continue on A337 through built up area to HQ, approx 1 mile

Local regulations

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

There are a number of potholes between Downton (1.9 miles) and Lymington (5 miles), the Highways Authority are aware and these may be filled in by the time of the event. One nasty one near Everton Hyundai garage was obscured by shadows when I recce'd it. Riders must take care in navigating the one way systems in Lymington and Lyndhurst, and be aware of pedestrians in built up areas.

SAFETY HELMETS and working rear lights are now mandatory.

DUTY OF CARE. The primary 'duty of care' rests with the riders. It is their responsibility to comply with traffic law andregulations; the Highway Code and the risk assessment. Failure to comply renders a rider liable to disqualification and possible further disciplinary action. Observe the measures taken by the Highways Authorityto reduce risks and conflict with other road users, and ride in a manner that is safe for yourselves and all others. Accept that you participate at your own risk and rely on your own ability and judgementin dealing with all hazards.

Please read the course description carefully and take note of the safety information therein.

No warming up on the course, Caird Avenue is ideal for this.

Covid 19 restrictions are in force so there will be no presentation, competitors should arrive shortly before their start time and must warm up on the road. (No turbos). Please maintain social distancing and bring your own pen for signing in and out. There will be no pusher off and numbers at the start will be restricted. You may wait across the road in Ashington Park prior to the start if you wish.

Toilets will be available in the scout hut and must be used in accordance withh Covid 19 guidelines.

Car parking is available aroud the scout hut and adjoining offices of New Milton Sand and Ballast Company but competitors must not gather in groups but leave as soon as possible after the event.
