

Route from HQ to start



Route HQ to Start

Total distance to start 1.3 miles.

Leave the village hall carpark by the one-way system and

Turn LEFT into Churchway (heading North),


Almost immediately at the double mini-RAB Turn RIGHT (heading East) along Wood Ways for approximately 0.3miles

At the next junction you will be joining the Time Trial course.

Turn RIGHT into Stanbridge Road and proceed along the course for a short distance, passing the Finish Line and then the Haddenham Garden Centre.

After a total of 1.0 miles just after a small bridge, turn left and ride a further 0.3m (total distance 1.3 miles), to the minor road on the left to Aston Sandford Church. Wait in this road to be called forward by the Start Time Keeper. Ensure that your back light is working – no light no ride.

Route Finish to HQ



Total distance to finish 1.1 miles.

Proceed pass Haddenham Garden Centre and at the next junction turn right into Aston Road, signposted Tiggywinkles Visitor Centre. Proceed past the Hedgehogs and at the next junction by the Duck Pond turn right into Churchway and then proceed back to the HQ, which is on the left.

Course details

Longwick Circuit Course (HCC178c) Description:

Start on the unnamed road between Stanbridge Road and the A4129 at a point 36* yards east of the minor road to Aston Sandford and opposite a field gate. Continue to the junction with the A4129 where turn left (M1). Continue southeast on A4129 through Longwick to the roundabout at the junction with the B4009 at the Sportsman's Garage. Take the first exit (M2) onto the B4009 and proceed to the second turning on the left. Turn left (M3) and go through Ford to the Haddenham-Aylesbury crossroads. Turn left (M4) (Check) to the first junction at Haddenham. Turn left (M5) for 0.22 mile to a point 30 yards before telegraph pole no. 05 and 0.02 miles before the entrance to the garden centre where finish.

Marshals referred to in this course description (M1, M2) etc may be provided solely to indicate the course direction. They have no role whatsoever in the risk assessment itself.

Local regulations

LWDC 2 – Restriction of Parking at the Start and Finish. No vehicles, with the exception of the Timekeepers' Assistant shall be parked in the vicinity of the Start or Finish points.

LWDC 7 – Location of Numbers Riders' numbers shall be issued from the headquarters.

LWDC 8 – Prohibition of U-Turns U-Turns are not permitted within sight of the Start or Finish points, nor on the course. Offenders will be liable to disqualification and will be reported to the District Committee. This may lead to disciplinary action being taken against the rider.

A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby.
